

## STREET FURNITURE CASE STUDY



### Millennium Town Park – St. Helier Jersey

**Project Overview:** The site for the Millennium Town Park is situated in a built up residential area to the north of St. Helier town centre. It is an old Gas Works site that has been decontaminated and transformed into a landmark public park. Benchmark were asked to supply furniture that was sympathetic to a contemporary park environment, and that offered ease of maintenance, value for money and an extended lifespan. The CHICO bench from the Wales & Wales range was selected, constructed in FSC European oak it is a robust design with an expected lifespan of at least 15 years with little maintenance required. The manufacturing phase of the project ran over a 10-week period and included supplying a stainless steel ground fixing system. Benchmark worked closely with both the Architect and construction company to ensure that the detailed project requirements were met both on time and within budget.
