The journey began almost three years ago, with an approach by an interior design team from Studio Mica, to the Laufen International Hotel Specification team at Salone, the international design event in Milan. The exacting requirements for this prestigious project were clear from the offset, with no room for compromise. A bespoke approach was the only solution for this special collaboration and Laufen was able to meet the needs of this very specific brief, which called for a subtle, yet luxurious finish.

### The Specification

Each bathroom was to include several key pieces:

The shower tray. Chosen for its stylish and contemporary look with a gel coat surface and made entirely from Marbond. Cast as one piece, each flat tray was custom built to fit perfectly in each of the 150 bathrooms. Made from a mineral composite, it is a robust material which is anti-bacterial, easy-to-clean, resistant to chemicals and UV-resistant.

Laufen Pro WC. Carefully selected for its stylish design, comfort and functionality for every spatial situation, it continues the sleek and luxurious theme.

Stunning freestanding baths are included in the suites, creating a striking focal point. Created in a stylish, bespoke curved design, the bath tubs take residence at the foot of the bed. Made from Sentec solid surface, the deep baths provide a spa-like sense of wellbeing and exude luxury.

Lastly a truly signature piece, offering a luxurious touch of gold. The stunning bespoke gold basins provide the exquisite final touch to the perfectly designed space of both the standard bedrooms, as well as the suites. The basin itself effortlessly creates a sense of subtle luxury, with its contemporary design and shimmering gold finish, contrasting with the minimalist and sleek white of the other bathroom pieces.
