Dublin City Council are centralising all their highways services into one new purpose-built depot located to the north of the city centre. As an existing client they approached us directly to coordinate with the project architects and develop a new 'onbrand' identity and site wayfinding solution.

The complex site has public access, extensive vehicular movement, a central administration office building, multi storey car park and construction and maintenance workshops. Our challenge was to create a holistic approach that worked well for vehicular and pedestrian users and presented an integrated graphic style with an on-brand aesthetic that reflected the environmental needs of each building.


