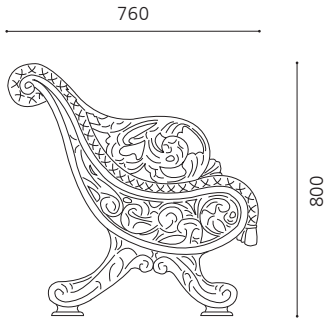


## ROTHERHAM SEAT RANGE

The Rotherham - a distinctive floral-style cast iron seat with timber slats arranged in a scrolled profile - is a replica of a Victorian original, first thought to have been used in London's parks and which continues to be used today in the capital's Royal Parks. The closely aligned iroko timber slats, which are profiled around the tight scrolls at the top and bottom of the seat, provide a generously proportioned and comfortable seat / backrest support.



### ROTHERHAM

Cast iron standards - painted finish, to any BS / RAL colour reference.  
Iroko timber slats - smooth planed finish

#### RH 6

3 person seat, 1860 mm long

#### RH 7

4 person seat, 2160 mm long

#### RH 8

4 person seat, 2460 mm long

#### OPTIONS:

- Centre arm
- Timbers with UV protective finish
- Engraved bronze plaque

#### INSTALLATION:

A steel fixing plate is fitted to the underside of each foot, which is pre-drilled for an M10 or M12 ground fixing (not supplied)
