

# Hanging Baskets

Hanging baskets capture the sweet scents of spring, with stunning cascades of floral wonder lifting the spirit.

Unlike traditional hanging baskets, Amberol **Self-watering** baskets don't leak; they minimize evaporation; they need only be watered once or twice a week. In short, they **save water, time and money!**



## Top Tips

**For safe installation and planting of your Hanging Baskets**

1. Place your new Hanging Basket on a suitable, stable surface.
2. Release and detach one section of quick release chain; lay the chain system to one side for easy access.
3. Fill the basket with moist compost, and slow release fertiliser if desired, and plant up as required. Plant up densely for best results. **DO NOT** fill the water reservoir at this point.
4. Re-secure the hanging chain system checking that all the karabiner clips are closed properly.
5. When ready, carefully hang the basket from an appropriately mounted bracket. Lock the chain to the bracket if necessary.
6. The integral water reservoir can now be filled with water and nutrient. Leave the unique **Aquafeed™** capillary action matting to do the rest!
7. Make one final check to ensure that the bracket and basket are properly secure.
8. Top up with water and nutrient no more than twice a week.

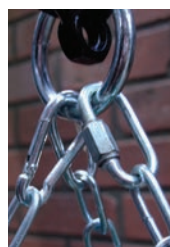
