

1. Application – Sled Lane

The **TVS Sports Carpet** is a suitable material to use as a sled track in a gym. This means a fully laden sled can be pushed or pulled across the training surface without damage. The surface provides a good grip underfoot and when combined with a shock pad the area is suitable for plyometric activities. It is also the ideal surface for speed, agility and quickness drills.



2. Material

- The **Sports Carpet** is manufactured in the UK.
- It is made using 4-way stitched, needle-punched polypropylene.
- A 100% UV stabilized product is available on request and this is suitable for outdoor gym areas.
- Lines, numbers and custom branding can be easily integrated into the design.

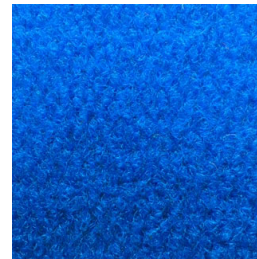

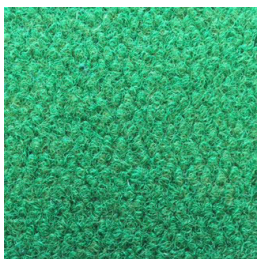

4. Dimensions / Tolerances

5. Installation Recommendations

It is recommended that the material be fully adhered directly to the subfloor. The subfloor must be clean, smooth and solid, within an acceptable tolerance level of +/-3mm over a 3m straight edge. The correct adhesives must be used.

6. Maintenance Guide

Inspect the condition of the surface on a daily basis and use a use a sweeping brush or a vacuum cleaner to remove any light debris. Check all seams regularly. Ensure the correct footwear is worn at all times. All footwear should be clean before using the track.

A synthetic track and its surrounding areas should be a no smoking zone, as a cigarette will melt the surface fibres, leaving an unsightly mark. Chewing gum and the use of glass bottles should also be banned from the performance area. Appropriate signs should be erected, displaying information to the users on the rules that need to be observed to ensure everyone can enjoy the area in a safe environment. Do not allow equipment with narrow wheels or tyres to run over the surface. All maintenance equipment should be tested prior to use to ensure no grooves or carpet rucking is evident.
