The Croft Theatre is a professional performance space at Edward Alleyn's School in Dulwich. Designed by awardwinning architects van Heyningen and Haward at a total cost of £12.5 million, the theatre boasts the latest technology and can seat an audience of 350. It is also used by the National Youth Theatre, which was founded at Alleyn's in 1956 by Michael Croft. The school and the NYT have launched many dramatic careers including Colin Farrell, Jude Law and Samuel West.

Lang+Fulton (formerly Orsogril UK) designed and supplied the roof-top screening to obscure the extensive air conditioning and service plant. Detailed fabrication drawings were submitted for approval as the panels and a series of 7 doors had to be individually sized to fit around the piping and ductwork.

These were made from **Louvre Talia-80** and extended to an overall length of 50 metres.

The steel louvres provide 80% visual screening.
