Edinburgh University has taken the first steps towards implementing a masterplan for major regeneration at the heart of its campus.

The project architects, Bennetts Associates, describe the scheme as "the replacement of a windswept car park with a rich mix of buildings, courtyards and reinstated street-lines. The first of 3 phases is a state of the art building for the School of Informatics. Externally, the prefabricated elevations play on the distinction between the stone faced streets of Edinburgh, and the need for more light reflective surfaces to the courtyard.

Lang+Fulton were asked to supply **Stereo-4** grating panels for a large bike store, prominently located within the central courtyard. It was important that the materials and simple geometric shapes should harmonize with the surrounding architectural concept, without dominating the space.

The large 2.5x2m galvanized panels, fulfilled this brief and the robust grating with a 30x4mm flat bar provided the required security.
