

North Kent Police HQ is a four-storey landmark building of 11,500m². Glenn Howells Architects were responsible for developing the building concept which features a number of 'green' technologies including solar shading to the south façade which is provided by means of brise soleil.

These aesthetics were complemented by an inner perimeter fence from the Lang+Fulton range of steel louvred fencing. The *Italia-100* which provides 100% visual screening was considered appropriate for the required high level of security.

The 2.2m fencing panels were mounted on a dwarf wall to protect against the possibility of ramming by carjackers which was considered to be a potential threat. Access was provided by both sliding and swing gates.

In addition to the fencing, Louvre-100 panels were used to securely enclose an adjacent 3m high generator compound.
