Overview

A bespoke version of the Façade Flush cubicle system was used to stunning effect, with a mixture of Alpi Noce real wood veneer and high gloss Blanc Megève laminate on a robust 44mm chipboard core. The laminate has been post-formed to produce the feature curved pilasters. Solid surface vanity units complete a striking combination of Grant Westfield washroom solutions.

While Façade Flush is traditionally specified with real wood veneers in the commercial sector, the system is also versatile enough to be used with high pressure laminate, and as illustrated here at Scottish Widows, can satisfy the most intriguing design needs. In addition the system was modified for education at the award winning and iconic Westminster Academy. In this form Façade Flush was made from solid grade laminate and incorporated acoustic rated partitions for maximum student privacy.



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
