Nature:

Raised vegetable planting boxes are perfect for digging and encouraging children to nurture plants from seed to harvest, building confidence and providing a sense of achievement. This can be included into lessons to teach where food comes from and can lead to discussions about favourite foods and tastes.

Fine motor skill development is promoted through manipulating tools, digging, and patting and children learn to use a range of equipment from spades to rakes.

The Bug Bungalow whilst providing multiple habitats in a small space also can be used as a sensory teaching aid for comparisons which will include different shapes, materials, colours, textures and sizes.

Log piles are a simple way of increasing biodiversity at your school and provide a rich resource for teaching science.
