A nursery play space was designed and built to incorporate dens, active play elements, music and sand features, a slide, decks and pond - all without sacrificing the spirit of the 'garden' it occupied.

The 'garden' was the attractive characteristic of this nursery outside play space but the garden could only be used in dry weather and provided only limited play value.

The design successfully improved the playability of all the play spaces without sacrificing the sense of a 'garden' with plants and green and nature everywhere you looked.
