- The system provides openness and light to the balcony user, whilst the width of the vertical bars provide privacy from the outside aspect
- The product incorporates a balcony fascia plate to provide a complete solution that minimises coordination challenges with other trades and contractors
- Each vertical bar is individually fixed to the folded fascia plate with **concealed fixings**

- Over a long period of time, the aluminium powder coated finish is less susceptible to corrosion than traditional steel
- The B50 system is a weld free, mechanically assembled aluminium balustrade system that can be installed in large modules to facilitate fast installation
- The B50 system is significantly lighter than a traditional solid welded steel system which reduces imposed loads on the balcony structures and greatly facilitates quicker handling and installation



SIDE FIX TECHNICAL DETAILS



1. Product Assembly: The system is comprised of aluminium extruded parts that are mechanically assembled with concealed fixings. This removes the need for unsightly welds that have the potential for failure.

2. Fascia: The side fix balustrade uprights utilises a fascia plate to give additional balustrade stability. This removes the need for further trims, fascia's or copings to the edges of balconies and terraces.

3. Fixing: Bespoke support brackets, such as a folded steel plate, can be designed to accommodate different balcony and terrace scenarios.

4. Finish: B50 is available in a polyester powder coat finish which offers a huge range of colour options. The anodised option provides a contemporary appearance and offers a corrosion and abrasion resistant finish.

Modular

Due to the lightweight aluminium alloy used in the product, the system can be assembled in our offsite manufacture facility in large modules. These sections, such as a balcony side, can then be transported to site and fitted.

Loadings and Certifications

The product has been load tested to meet a 0.74kN/m loading. This is suitable for all private residential balconies and terraces.

The B50 system provides a flat and continuous edge to enable easy integration with the site waterproofing strategy.
