


The boards have the appearance of concrete but with the unique textural delicacy of fibre cement.


Each board is unique and their visual appearance is bought to life as the weather and lighting conditions change – offering the facade an unparalleled, dynamic visual appeal.

Cembrit Patina boards are available in two natural finishes; textured and sanded surface (Cembrit Patina) and a new 'velvety' and structured surface (Cembrit Patina Rough).

Exceptional durability

Cembrit Patina boards combine robustness and ease of use with elegant and ever-changing aesthetics. Cembrit Patina is a homogeneous facade board. As an uncoated genuine material, Cembrit Patina is closer in appearance to natural and monolithic facade boards than those with applied surface coatings, but has the benefit of fibre cement's low weight per m2. Additionally, as there is no surface coating, minor damage is less visible than on coated facade boards.

Thanks to our in-house expertise, Cembrit has captured the intrinsic quality of fibre cement, preserved it and re-invented it to make it a unique visual feature.



Natural Building Material

Cembrit Patina & Cembrit Patina Rough boards are made from: cement, mineral fillers and water, to which organic fibres are added.

Over time, the boards will patinate, giving the facade a characterful, natural look.

The result is a virtually maintenance-free facade with exceptional durability - that develops character and grace


A key advantage of the hydrophobated surface of the boards is their strong dirt, stain and water-repellent properties, as well as their resistance to all kinds of weather conditions: frost and thaw, heat and extreme rainfall.

Cembrit Patina

Cembrit Patina has a natural, textured surface. The fibres and natural characteristics of the fibre cement are visible and the grain on the surface of the boards give an extra tactile and visual impact. As the seasons change and the years pass, the natural ageing of the fibre cement leaves subtle traces on the surface, and the facade will gradually acquire a distinctive patina.



Cembrit Patina Rough

Cembrit Patina Rough has a velvety, structured surface - as if formed over time by Nature. This appearance will add a mineral, naturally and subtly eroded surface finish to your facade, as if it were built using natural materials - for instance, naturally aged sandstone.

The sandblasted surface will also give your facade a dynamically changing appearance throughout the day depending on external light and viewing angle. As with Cembrit Patina, Cembrit Patina Rough will patinate with time - enriching its natural appearance.








