At East Haddon, in the rolling countryside of Northamptonshire in England, Haddonstone has beautiful show gardens and an interior showroom where visitors can see many of the designs illustrated in this catalogue in their proper settings, see opposite. The garden and showroom are open every week from Monday to Friday ~ public holidays and Christmas period excepted ~ between the hours of 9.00 am and 5.00 pm. The gardens are also open on occasional weekends as part of the National Garden Scheme (Yellow Book) to raise money for charity. Brown tourism signs guide visitors to the gardens from the A428.

Haddonstone pieces may also be viewed at stockists across the UK as well as the RHS gardens at Wisley and Harlow Carr. WHY HADDONSTONE?

Haddonstone is a unique form of cast limestone with a surface texture similar to Portland stone. The material matures and weathers like natural stone yet, piece for piece, normally costs significantly less than quarried stone.

The ability to mould the Haddonstone material into almost any shape ~ faithfully reproducing new designs or producing replicas that are virtually indistinguishable from an antique original ~ has won the company numerous contracts ranging from leading international hotels and retail developments to listed National Trust properties and prestige residential projects.

The material used in every design, from the smallest planter to the largest Corinthian column, exceeds the compressive cube strength requirements of the United Kingdom Cast Stone Association and complies with all relevant UK and European standards, whilst TecStone also meets the requirements of all US standards.

Each design is hand made by Haddonstone in the UK or USA using moulds created within the company's extensive mould shops and studios. Using these same facilities Haddonstone can even manufacture non-standard architectural stone pieces to practically any shape, size or colour.

As Haddonstone maintains original models and/or moulds for every single design in the standard collection, and utilises the very latest vapour curing technology, customers can be reassured that the high quality of each stone produced is incredibly consistent whilst retaining the individuality of a hand-made product. The company even offers a five year warranty on cast stone garden ornaments.

Haddonstone can also be an enjoyable investment. At a Sotheby's auction, four Haddonstone Plaited Baskets sold for more than twenty times their current retail value.

Clarence Urn

A215

This elegant urn, inspired by the designs of the Regency period, has been crafted by Haddonstone as a complementary piece to the Regency and Trafalgar Urns. The simple design has leaf moulding to the rim and gadrooning to the bowl. Identical in proportion to the Large Clarence Urn A214, see page 21.

Croyland Vase A245

A small campana-shaped vase featuring a stylised leaf design. This vase was replicated from an original in a private Northamptonshire garden.

Magnolia Vase A490

A simple campana-shaped vase with a circular base incorporating acanthus-leaf moulding around the bowl. The original dates back to the XVII century in the style of Christopher Wren.

Vine Urn A705

This charming small urn features vine decoration and gadrooning to the body and overlapping leaf decoration around the rim. Ideal for use in conjunction with Haddonstone balustrading.

West Lodge Urn

HA780

Featuring gadrooning to the bowl, this elegant small urn was originally replicated for West Lodge Park Hotel in Hertfordshire.

An urn of early XIX century design with egg and dart moulding around the rim and a fluted base. This urn can be used as a decorative ornament on balustrade piers.

Sheraton Vase A610

Designed by Haddonstone, this charming vase features gadrooning and fluting to the bowl, enriched around the rim with rods and ribbons in the style of Sheraton. Ideal for interior planting in conservatories and garden rooms.

House of Dun Urn

Commissioned by the National Trust for Scotland to replace the originals at the House of Dun as part of the major restoration programme. The Trust has since granted permission to include the urn in the Haddonstone Collection.

Gothic Urn and Base A370

A Regency-period octagonal urn with single quatrefoil panels mounted on a waisted square base. These impressive urns line the Rose Walk at Lambeth Palace. Gothic Vase (see below), Gothic Jardiniere (page 33) and Large Gothic Jardiniere (page 32) also available.

Florentine Urn A290

Reproduced from an ornate early XIX century urn acquired from Florence, this design is swathed in a rich vine relief, with gadrooning around the base.




Etruscan Vase A280

The beautiful Etruscan Vase was commissioned by a private client and features a simple campana shape with gadrooning to the bowl and an egg and dart rim.

Versailles Vase A690

A simple campana-shaped state vase with restrained gadrooning to the bowl. Identical in proportion to Large Versailles Vase A680, see page 22. This design was replicated from a Blashfield original.



Gothic Vase A380

Regency-style octagonal vase with single quatrefoil panels. Ideal for decorating a terrace. Gothic Urn and Base (see above), Gothic Jardiniere (page 33) and Large Gothic Jardiniere (page 32) also available.

Width at top: 565mm (221/4") Width at base: 400mm (153/4") Height: 590mm (231/4") Weight: 70kg (154 lb)



Eastwell Urn

A260

A large, elegant tazza with elaborately interlaced ribbonwork decoration around the bowl. It can also be supplied in fountain form as a centrepiece (see C200 on page 84).

Shugborough Vase A585

The Shugborough Vase is a replica of an original we were commissioned to replace at Shugborough Hall. The proportions of this vase allow its use as a decorative ornament to enhance Haddonstone balustrading.

A220

The National Trust commissioned this replica to replace damaged vases at Cliveden, Buckinghamshire.

Large Acanthus Urn 0997

Taken from a Doulton original of c1840, this elegant design features bold gadrooning and acanthus leaf decoration.

Warwick Castle Urn A740

Haddonstone was commissioned by Warwick Castle to reproduce this urn as part of the castle's restoration project for the rose garden.

French Urn A320










The abstract pattern of this vase with stylised Ashoka buds, tendrils and leaf nodes results from a cultural blend of Islamic and Indian traditions.

The Hadrian Vase combines a half-gadrooned bowl with egg-and-dart rim, a circular socle and square base. The Hadrian Vase is also available with handles, see right.

restrained gadrooning to the bowl incorporating scrolled handles.

Westonbirt Urn A755

Commissioned as a commemoration by the governors of Westonbirt School, Gloucestershire. The original was manufactured by Pulham from a design attributed to the architect Lewis Vulliamy who was active in the early XIX century. This scaled-down version is typical of his style, featuring spiralled gadrooning and egg-and-dart rim.

Width at top: 700mm (27¾") Height: 650mm (25½") Width at base: 380mm (15¼") Weight: 129kg (285 lb)



Winslow Vase A770 Winslow Pedestal B350

An unusual design with fluted decoration and leaf mouldings. Its elegant proportions make it ideal for entrances and walkways.


Jubilee Urn A440

A special limited edition of twenty-five was launched at the Chelsea Flower Show. A standard edition is now a part of the Haddonstone Collection.



Tatham Tazza Q998

Gallé Vase A325
