NOTE: WALLRACKTM are intended to be installed on 16 inch centers with lag screws into wall stud or Tapcons into concrete wall. A minimum clearance on rack centers is 16 inches and minimum vertical high-low offset is not less than 11 inches for adequate handlebar clearance.

The new **WALLRACK**[™] creates vertical storage of the bicycle to remove most of the footprint of the bike from the bike parking area (garage or basement) floor space.

The old "J" hooks from the rafters, create stress on the wheelsets of expensive and light weight alloy bike rims found on today's bicycles. **WALLRACK™** supports the bikes front wheel in a very bike-friendly configuration that avoids damage.

avoids damage. Just roll the bike up to the WALLRACK[™], lift the front

end of the bike and place its front wheel within the rack and roll forward until it rests in a positive stop position.

With a little practice, an 8 year old is able to easily park the bike in the **WALLRACK**TM.
